Glen gave a report on the Chippewa watershed and about low interest loans available to upgrade your septic systems. Douglas County has \$175,000.00 in grants available for the upgrades.

John Stone from Lobster Lake Association gave a speech on some of the things they do with their Association. Which including stocking Lobster Lake with walleyes.

An update on the Sewer Project was given by Jim Adam. Phase I should start in 2005 with construction in 2007.
